- Entry is by pre-arrangement by completing the Bush Poet's Breakfast Entry Form.
- The Festival of the Fleeces Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any candidate if they are deemed unsuitable for any reason.
- Walk-up entries are accepted on the day but if places are limited priority will be given on a "first in, first served" basis.

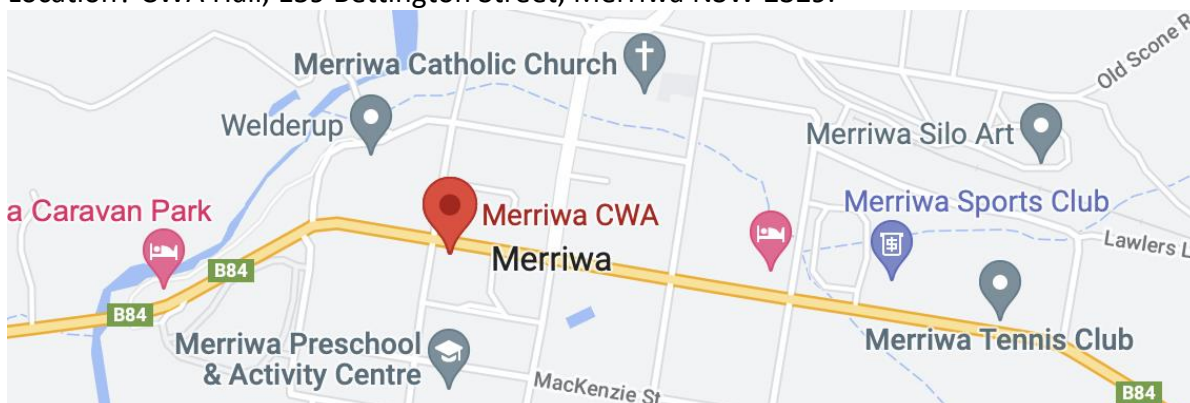
Venue, Time and Location and Information
